Kirsten Mogensen is an Associate Professor at Roskilde University in Denmark. During the last few years, she has been interested in how public diplomacy can contribute to trust building. In 2013 she participated in the CPD Summer Institute in Public Diplomacy at University of Southern California, and she recently published the article "International Trust and Public Diplomacy" in *International Communication Gazette*, vol. 77, 2015. Mogensen has previously published extensively in the area of terrorism coverage - especially about the coverage in US national television of the events on September 11, 2001. She has been affiliated with Stanford University, Louisiana State University, and University of Minnesota - either as a visiting scholar or as a student - and has been a professional journalist for many years. Sometimes she takes leave from the university and joins international monitoring missions, e.g. in 2015 she works with election observation for The Carter Center in Myanmar, and in 2005-06 she was Chief Press, Information and Protocol Officer in the Aceh Monitoring Mission, Indonesia.
