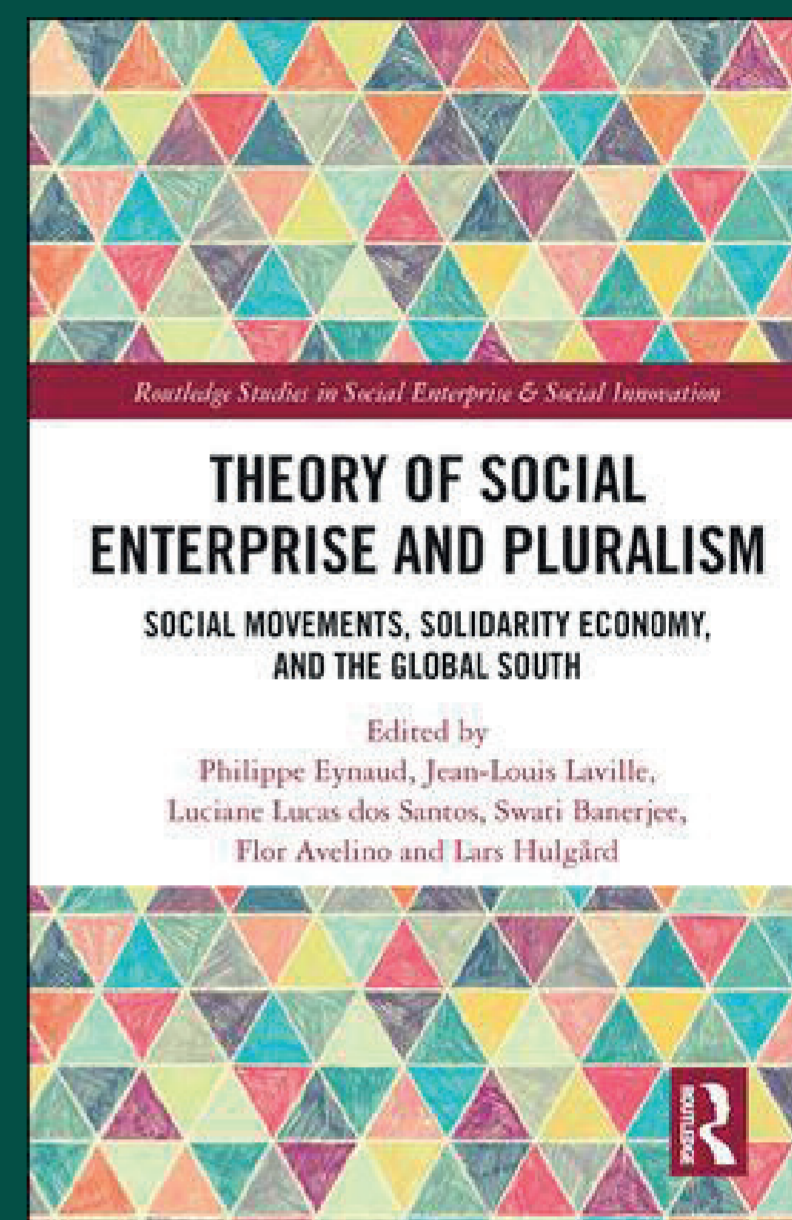
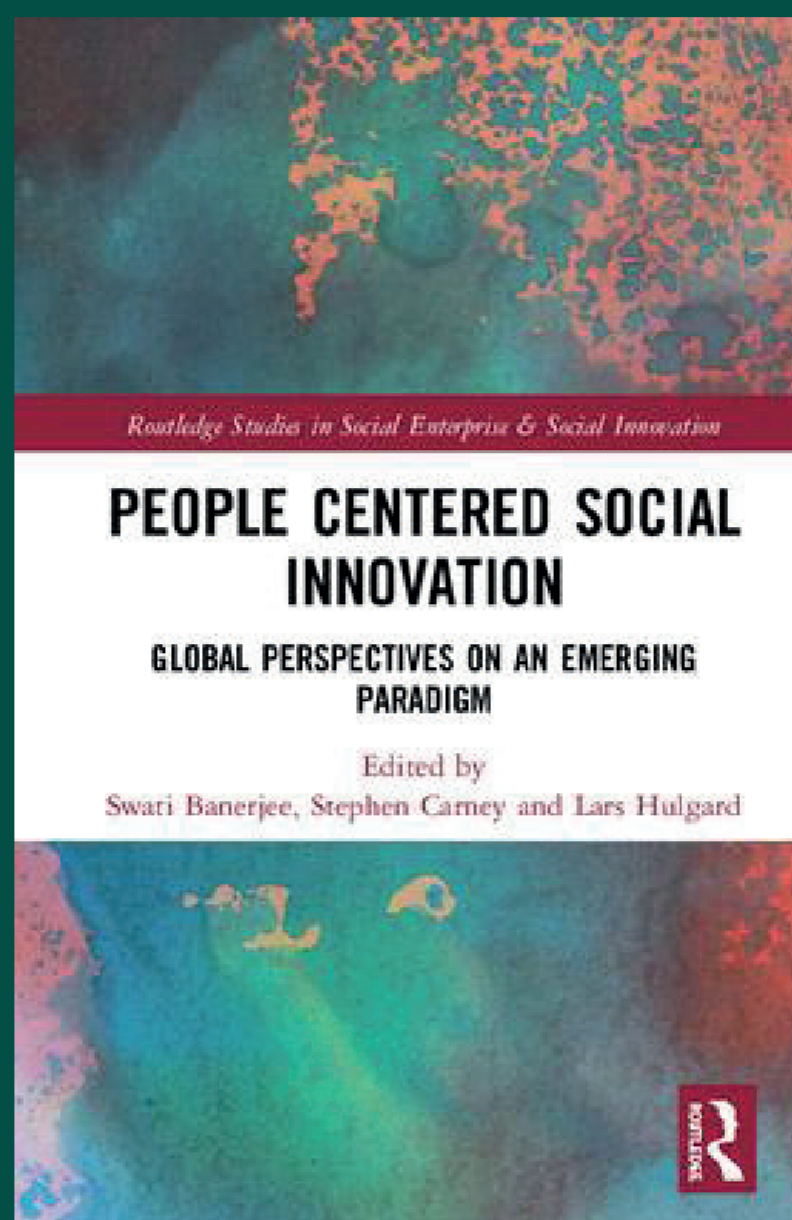


Book Launch on Social Enterprise

With two new books, scholars from the Global South and the Global North are providing important new directions in the search for a common, sustainable future.

Both books are the product of long-term collaborations between RUC researchers and colleagues worldwide and aim at furthering genuine South North dialogue in the service of creating a different future. This includes arguing that economic and social justice cannot be achieved without epistemological justice and a sensitivity towards other knowledges.



The research underpinning both projects is aimed at strengthening egalitarian solidarity and reciprocity through an awareness of the potentials within social innovation, social enterprise and solidarity economy. Professor Jean-Louis Laville will provide a framing perspective on the field. He is a global thought leader connecting concerns for plural economy and egalitarian solidarity with social innovation.
