

Curriculum Vitae Claus Bundgård Christensen (1968) is Associate Professor of History at Roskilde University, Denmark. Primary Research Areas He has published a number of scholarly books and articles in Danish, English, French and German on The First World War, Crime and Control, The Second World War, Holocaust, Nazism and the Nazi war of extermination at the Eastern front, Right-Wing Extremism, Radicalism. He has published books and contributions to books at Oxford University Press, Palgrave, Routledge, Bloomsbury, Verlag Ferdinand Schöningh and Presses universitaires de Strasbourg. He is the author and co-author of a number of praised books including *Under hagekors og Dannebrog-Danskere i Waffen SS (Danes in the Waffen-SS)*, *Den Sorte Børs (Black Market Crime during the Occupation and postwar years)*, *Danskere på vestfronten 1914-1918 (Danes on the Western Front 1914-1918)*, *Danmark besat-krig og hverdag 1940-45 (Denmark occupied 1940-1945)*, *Waffen-SS-Europas nazistiske soldater (Waffen-SS. The European Nazi soldiers)*. His latest book is *Fra verdenskrig til borgerkrig. Østfronten 1914-1924. Set med danske øjne (From world war to civil war. The Eastern Front 1914-1924)*. In 2007 he received a generous grant from the Velux Foundation on project about whether a distinctive type of war experience developed among the soldiers from the Danish minority in Schleswig south of the Dano-German border who were conscripted into the German Army during the First World War. In 2009 he received a generous grant from the Danish Research Council with Peter Scharff Smith and Niels Bo Poulsen to the project *The History of the Waffen- SS. Ideology, Atrocities, and Reckoning with the Past*. This project is a study of Waffen-SS as a transnational organization. In 2018 he received a grant from The Augustinus Foundation to the project *Wilfred and his Danish Boys 1932-1947 (Wilfred og de danske drenge)*. This project is at study of Wilfred Petersen and his organization who invented a Nordic form of Nazism in the interwar period. The project will be finished in the fall of 2021. In 2020 he received a grant from Nordic Council to the project *Pan-Nordic and Transnational Dimensions of Nordic Right-Wing Extremism*.
